Gerard, it was 11Sep18 when Bo arrived in the US. Today is his birthday and he is one year old. I thought you might like to hear how Bo is doing.

Bo is healthy and I believe happy. He weights about 65 pound now and is starting to get more muscular. He is a wonderful companion. He is bonded closely with his "pack", i.e. myself and my wife, and is almost always in the same room as one or both of us. He has a habit of taking my hand and loosely holding my hand in his mouth. He loves to play toss & fetch.

His training as a cadaver / human remains detection dog is proceeding. He knows the scent and indicates (sit and then down) when he finds the source. He has a hunting instinct and uses scent in the air to find the source. His off- leash training is progressing and I use a whistle for commands. He needs more maturing and continued exposure to different experiences. I believe in another 6 months he will be operational.

Let me say once more that I appreciate you trusting Bo to me. Bo is loved and cared for to the best of our ability.
